

## SINGULAR INTEGRALS WITH MIXED HOMOGENEITY IN PRODUCT SPACES

**Abstract.** Let  $\Omega \in L(\log L^+)^2(S^{n-1} \times S^{m-1})$  ( $n, m \geq 2$ ) satisfy some cancellation conditions. We prove the  $L^p$  boundedness ( $1 < p < \infty$ ) of the singular integral

$$Tf(x_1, x_2) = p. v. \int_{\mathbb{R}^n \times \mathbb{R}^m} \frac{\Omega(y'_1, y'_2) h(\rho_1(y_1), \rho_2(y_2))}{\rho_1^\alpha(y_1) \rho_2^\beta(y_2)} f(x_1 - y_1, x_2 - y_2) dy_1 dy_2,$$

where  $\rho_1, \rho_2$  are some metrics which are homogeneous with respect to certain non-isotropic dilations. We also study the above singular integral along some surfaces.

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
